A huge event for the competitors, spectators and fans of trophy-raid with the participation of the best drivers not only from Baltic states or Scandinavia, but also from Russia. 2nd Stage of 2010 FIA NEZ Trophy-raid Championship, as well as the stage of Latvian and Lithuanian Open Championship in trophy-raid – three different events, all in the same time, in the same place – in Latvia, Rugaji, from 13 – 16 august.

**What to expect in Rugaji?**

- Legendary lap of Medni – now even more challenging and interesting for the riders and as well for the spectators. More mud, new fords for competitors and better places for the spectators and fans.
- Orienteering with some spicy elements in swamp woods areas.
- GPS legends in specially prepared tracks.

**For the spectators!**

- Two days to follow the race and watch the best off-road drivers in the course and in the mud.
- In between the sport categories in the racing lap of mud the mud enthusiasts will compete for the title of the “Eagle of Mud” (unconditional fight, available to all off-roaders).
- Not only the off-road competition will entertain the audience. Different surprises, including the concert in the evening, are intended for the spectators.

All owners of 4x4 vehicles have the chance to feel the spirit of competition by participating in the competition of Tourism cup. Course can be accomplished with standard off-road vehicle (with low gear). During the race the participants of Tourism cup will have the chance to test the abilities of their off-road vehicles in simple off-road conditions, as well the possibility to drive up to and see the nearest objects of cultural and historical significance (including those who are only accessible by off-road car).

All participants can book a place for the tent, or use the premises of Rugaji School as lodging, if declared earlier.
